



## RIDING ESTABLISHMENT RENEWAL OF LICENCE OR APPLICATION FOR EXTENSION OF PROVISIONAL LICENCE

### RIDING ESTABLISHMENTS ACTS 1964 AND 1970

1. A licence may be granted to an individual over the age of eighteen years or a corporate body. It will be a condition of any licence granted that the carrying on of the business of a riding establishment shall at no time be left in the charge of any person under 16 years of age.
2. It will be a condition of any licence granted that no horse will be let out on hire for riding or used for providing instruction in riding without supervision by a responsible person of the age of 16 years or over unless (in the case of a horse let out for hire for riding) the holder of the licence is satisfied that the hirer of the horse is competent to ride without supervision.
3. It will also be a condition of any licence granted that:
  - (i) a horse found unfit cannot be returned to work until the owner at his OWN expense has lodged with the Local Authority a veterinary certificate that the horse is fit.
  - (ii) a register open for inspection must be kept of horses aged 3 years and under.
  - (iii) no horse shall be let out for riding or instruction in riding or for the purpose of demonstrating riding, aged 3 years or under, or any mare heavy with foal, or any mare within 3 months after foaling.
- 4.(i) "Horse" includes any mare, gelding, pony, colt, filly or stallion, and also any ass, mule or jenny.
  - (ii) The Acts regulate riding establishments which let out horses on hire or use them for the purpose of providing, in return for payment, instruction in riding or for the purpose of demonstrating riding.
5. The licence is valid from the date of issue.
