



European Union citizens – European Parliament voter registration form

If you are a citizen of one of the European Union (EU) countries listed below, you can register to vote in the UK at a European Parliamentary election. Elections to the European Parliament take place every five years. The next election is scheduled for June 2009.

If you are a citizen of the Republic of Ireland, Malta or Cyprus, you are eligible to register to vote at all UK elections and so **do not** need to use this form. Ask your local electoral registration office for an appropriate registration form.

Please read the following information before you fill in this form.

- A new electoral register is produced every year on 1 December. Names can be added and removed throughout the year. You can register to vote if you are 16 or over (but you cannot vote until your 18th birthday).
- **This form only registers you for European Parliamentary elections.** You should already have been included on the register of local electors by your electoral registration office. If you are not already registered, you can get a registration form for this purpose from your electoral registration office.
- You cannot vote at the European Parliamentary elections in more than one country. If you fill in this form, you are agreeing to vote in the UK and **not** in your home country. But remember, you can cancel this registration at any time.
- Each person applying must fill in a separate form. If you need more forms, please photocopy this form, contact your electoral registration office, or visit www.aboutmyvote.co.uk.
