

Rushcliffe Borough Council Dog Fouling Schedule

Land Designated by Description

1. All carriageways with a speed limit of 40 miles per hour or less and adjoining footpaths and verges.
2. All amenity open space land managed by a local authority and maintained in good order.
3. All footways and alleys not adjoining carriageways and over which the public are entitled or permitted to have access.
