Upper Broughton Parish Council has submitted the draft Upper Broughton Neighbourhood Plan to Rushcliffe Borough Council in accordance with Regulation 15 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 (as amended).

The Upper Broughton Neighbourhood Plan contains local objectives and planning policies which the Borough Council will use alongside the Local Plan when considering planning applications within the parish. The Borough Council is now required to publicise the draft neighbourhood plan for six-weeks and invite representations to be made during this period.
