• After briefly looking at National Policy framework, I can see that we at oaklands do not meet the criteria to be put forward for this

ie. ① where the greenspace is close by to the community it serves

Reply ① My land is not accessible or close by to the public. It is accessed by PRIVATE LANE - NO PUBLIC ACCESS. You can see this on the map of Gotham.

② where the greenspace holds special value to the community it serves.

Reply ② This is not the case - No Public Access

③ where the greenspace has particular local character etc.

Reply ③ It has no character -

It has no ridge/furrow or similar
It's a plain flat area with no features.

Also, I understand local policy for managing development within a local greenspace should be consistent with policy for Greenbelt.
