The notion of the Gotham Neighbourhood Plan is in principle supported in this consultation response. It is understood their aim - strictly-local-need housing there - considering if looming 'south of Clifton' occurs, and seeing how East Leake has expanded.

I essentially have the same stance to my April 2018 response, denoted below, there are though two additional points worth mentioning at this stage:

Proposal GOT10, at that location unfortunately its effect would 'mirror' housing 'south of Clifton'.

Bus Depot proposal, if the current bus depot went then it would be unsustainable and opposed if that were to 'south of Clifton', not only re location as to most of the bus network, but, e.g. depot light-pollution upon a wider and rural landscape.
