I wish to put forward my grassland at Radcliffe on Trent for consideration within the Rushcliffe Strategic Green Belt Review.

The land is the approx. 16 acre block including Island Lane, located between Holme Lane, the disused railway embankment / nature corridor and the Wharf Lane Recreation Ground.

I would consider possible joint future use for residential development, leisure and additional sports facilities, perhaps incorporating the Trent Valley Way being re-routed along the edge of the nature corridor in order to allow safe pedestrian access to the proposed County Council footpath from Holme Lane to the Radcliffe Cricket Ground facilities and Cotgrave Country Park.

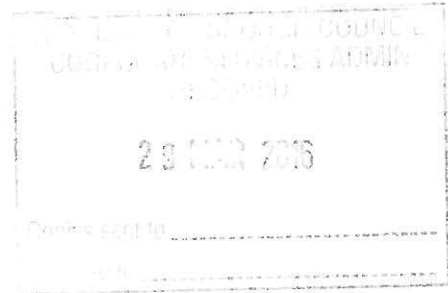

Further to my e-mail to your office – 24 March 2016, I wish to put forward the 16 acres (approx.) of land that is in my family ownership for consideration within the Rushcliffe Strategic Green Belt Review.

A location map is enclosed, the area marked within the red line. The land is bordered by Holme Lane, the disused mineral railway embankment / nature corridor and the Wharf Lane Recreation Ground, it also includes Island Lane.

I would put forward / consider possible joint future use of the land for residential development, leisure and additional sports area for the Wharf Lane Recreation Ground.

This may perhaps also incorporate the Trent Valley Way being re-routed along the edge of the nature corridor (marked broken blue line) in order to allow safe pedestrian access from the Recreation Ground to the Radcliffe Cricket Ground and the proposed County Council footpath on the disused embankment to Cotgrave Country Park.
