Notice is hereby given that Rushcliffe Borough Council adopted the East Midlands Freeport Strategic Infrastructure and Contributions Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) on **Tuesday 23 June 2026**.

The purpose of the SPD is to supplement policies contained in the Council's Local Plan. It will inform the Council's decisions when determining relevant planning applications.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the East Midlands Freeport Strategic Infrastructure and Contributions SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the SPD. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than three months after the date on which the SPD was adopted.
