Biodiversity needs your help

You can help us by recording wildlife in Nottinghamshire.

Knowing what species are present in

Nottinghamshire, and where they are, is an important means of monitoring our biodiversity and helps with the targeting of conservation activities. Your wildlife records, whether part of a detailed site survey or causal observations made on a weekend walk or from your own garden, are of great value, so please send them in!

To make the best use of your records, we require the following information:

- WHAT you saw species (common and scientific name if known), number of individuals, stage of lifecycle,
- WHERE you saw it the location, preferably a 6 figure National Grid Reference (or better) or a detailed written description (e.g. near the road sign in the grassy patch at the north end of Trent Street, West Bridgford).
- WHEN you saw it Date and time of your sighting
- WHO saw it Your name and contact details
