The Coal Authority is a non-departmental public body sponsored by the Department for Energy Security and Net Zero. As a statutory consultee, the Coal Authority has a duty to respond to planning applications and development plans in order to protect the public and the environment in mining areas.

We note that this consultation relates to acceptance, or otherwise, of modifications proposed by the Inspector for the Neighbourhood Plan. Our records indicate that the plan area, as identified, does not contain any recorded coal mining features at surface or shallow depth which may pose a risk to surface stability. On this basis the Planning Team at the Coal Authority have no specific comments to make on the decision statement.
