Notice is hereby given that Rushcliffe Borough Council adopted the Developer Contributions Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) on **Tuesday 9 December 2025**.

The purpose of the SPD is to supplement policies contained in the Council's Local Plan. It will inform the Council's decisions when determining relevant planning applications.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the Developer Contributions SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the SPD. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than three months after the date on which the SPD was adopted.
