Low Carbon and Sustainable Design Supplementary Planning Document

Notice is hereby given that Rushcliffe Borough Council adopted the Low Carbon and Sustainable Design Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) on **Tuesday 11 July 2023**.

The purpose of the SPD is to supplement policies contained in the Council's Local Plan. It will inform the Council's decisions when determining relevant planning applications.

Under Section 23(1) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004, the Council has modified the SPD to take into account representations made in relation to the document and other relevant matters. The modifications made are summarised in the Statement of Consultation.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the Low Carbon and Sustainable Design SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the SPD. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than three months after the date on which the SPD was adopted.
