Proposed site access




Proposed access to the southern parcel connects to the A60 via Wysall Road.

Two routes have been proposed to reduce construction traffic through Wysall village.

Exagen have engaged an independent highways consultant to refine the route and understand the best point of access. Agreement on this will be sought through consultation with the local highways authority.
