

PUBLIC NOTICE

Vehicle seized under Section 34B of the Environmental Protection Act 1990

On 12 May 2026 at approx. 6pm Rushcliffe Borough Council seized a White Ford Transit Van, registration YC10 DVW from Cherhill Close, Clifton, Nottingham.

The vehicle has been seized under Section 34B of the Environmental Protection Act 1990 as Rushcliffe Borough Council being the Enforcement Authority has reason to believe that:

- i. The vehicle has been used to deposit controlled waste on land other than in accordance with an Environmental Permit contrary to Section 33(1)(a) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990
- ii. The Vehicle has been used to transport controlled waste, and the driver of the vehicle is not registered as a waste carrier contrary to section 1 of the Control of Pollution (Amendment) Act 1989
- iii. The vehicle has been used in the commission of an offence consisting of a failure to comply with duties imposed by Section 34(1) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990

Any person wishing to make a claim of entitlement to the vehicle must do so by 3 June 2026. All claims of entitlement must be accompanied by the following information:

- a. Proof of Identity: The claimants name, address and proof of identity i.e. passport/drivers licence/photo identity card.
- b. Proof of Address: Two official documents displaying the applicant's name and address, to be dated no more than three months old.
- c. Where the claimant purports to be the registered keeper; the vehicle registration document V5C.
- d. Valid current certificate of motor insurance in the claimant's name and current address.
- e. If a vehicle is loaded with waste and/or scrap metal. A valid Waste Carriers Licence and written information duty of care documents for the load carried.
- c. Where the claimant is an agent making a claim on behalf of their principal; proof of authority to act on their behalf.

On receipt of a claim, The Council will determine the entitlement of the claimant. **IMPORTANT:** if no claim is made in respect of the vehicle within the time stipulated or if a claimant who brought a claim is determined as not entitled, the vehicle can be sold, destroyed or otherwise disposed of in accordance with Regulation 21 of the Control of Waste (Dealing with seized property) (England and Wales) Regulations 2015.
